## **Staff Welfare Measures to Retirees for 2013 – 2014**

We need to remember those faceless warriors of by-gone days carrying the identity as Pre-1986 retirees for the tears and sweat they had shed in those days through sustained struggle for survival of bankmen, besides fighting for nationalisation of banks. They had painstakingly built up the future of next generation of bank employees. These frail old timers of Pre-1986 had lent their hands for laying the foundation stones for the bank to earn super profit today. Now, in the last lap of their life, they live in despair. We, the next generation are reaping sweet fruits from the trees planted by them.

That is why, fervent appeals were made to our bank management in the last Grievances Cell Meeting at Bengaluru on 11<sup>th</sup> instant and also to the serving unions to consider paying additional amount to all the Pre-1986 retirees and surviving spouses.

It is learnt that the Chairman & Managing Director of our Bank has since permitted enhancement of medical reimbursement from Rs.2000/- to Rs.2500/- to superannuated retirees and SVRS & VRS retirees on existing terms and conditions, besides additional financial assistance of Rs.1,000/- p.m. to the Pre-1986 retirees and Rs.1,500/- p.m. to the surviving spouses of Pre-1986 retirees for the financial year 2013-2014.

We gratefully acknowledge the thoughtful gesture shown by our Chairman & Managing Director and the Staff Welfare Committee in our Bank for improving the welfare measures to the retired employees of our bank.

Also, please be informed that we are striving our best for introduction of contributory Hospitalisation Scheme through Group Mediclaim Policy by tie-up arrangement with an Insurance Company for the benefit of retirees in our bank and the Scheme is on the anvil.
